- Relocated the Reynolds House to our campus and Replaced the roof and conducted structural work on Old Admin Building

Next Up will be:

- Framing up the Reynolds House and taking down the Black House

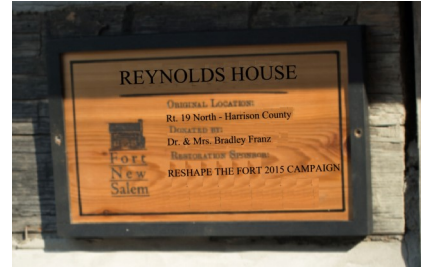
