THEY COME OUT AT NIGHT



Come see Fort New Salem in a different light.... Darkness! We are back for season 4 of "Myths of the Mountains" on **each Saturday night in July**. Join us as our story tellers come out at night.

Gates open at 8 PM welcoming visitors for an evening of Appalachia Tales. Guests will be accompanied by guides on a special night tour of Fort New Salem at dusk by lamplight with planned stops at multiple cabins for unique folklore tales by our costumed story tellers. Admission is \$7 per person and includes a complimentary cup of cider. The tour is approximately 1 hour 15 minutes in duration with the last group started at 9:30 PM.

IT IS DULCIMER TIME

Fort New Salem is alive with the sound of music **August 7—9** during our 25th Annual Dulcimer Festival. The weekend features hands-on music workshops during the day for all levels of players; tours of Fort New Salem; various non-music artisans demonstrating their craft. The workshops focus primarily on the mountain and hammered dulcimer with additional ones on other folk instruments. Musicians from Ohio, West Virginia and beyond lead the teaching. Daily general admission for visitors is \$7 with children 10 & under admitted free. There will be concerts on Friday and Saturday. The Friday concert is a "coffee house" style concert introducing several of the workshop leaders. The Saturday evening concert is our feature concert of the weekend. With Jim Miller on mountain and hammer dulcimer Chef Bo will be onsite cooking Pulled Pork Barbecue meals from 2 PM till 7:30 on Saturday.
