Fort New Salem is alive with the sound of music August 9—11 during our 23rd Annual Dulcimer Festival. The weekend features hands-on music workshops during the day for all levels of players; tours of Fort New Salem; various non-music artisans demonstrating their craft. The workshops focus primarily on the mountain and hammered dulcimer with additional ones on other folk instruments. Musicians from Ohio, West Virginia and beyond lead the teaching. Daily general admission for visitors is \$7 with children 10 & under admitted free.

There will be concerts on Friday and Saturday. The Friday concert is a “coffee house” style concert introducing several of the workshop leaders.
