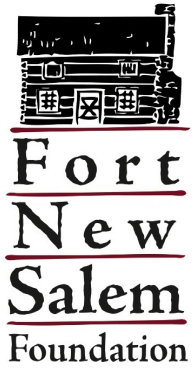

Fort New Salem opens for the 2017 season on Saturday, April 22 from noon to 5 PM with the 7<sup>th</sup> Annual John Randolph Spring Arts Kick Off. This special one-day event featuring live demonstrations by various artisans which may include paper marbling, printing, blacksmithing, herbal therapy, spoon carving, rug weaving, pottery and Appalachian spring cooking. Some of the demonstrators will have items for sale. Additionally, gifts will be available from vendors which include Boyce Art Glass, candles, incense and tie dye. Our gift shop will also be open. As an added feature for 2017, we will have an on-site food vendor. There will also be exhibits from the WV Division of Natural Resources and the American Chestnut Foundation. Feature entertainment is the Powell Family Band. General admission is \$5 with children 10 and under admitted free.

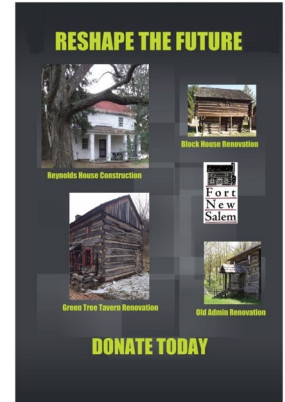
